### REFORMED EPISCOPAL SEMINARY AUXILIARY ANNOUNCES 2006-07 PROJECT

The 2006-07 project for the Seminary Auxiliary will be to raise funds for the purpose of updating the library computer system. Last year's project was designated to the library computer system as well. The estimated cost to update the system is \$10,000. The current system has been used since the Seminary was in West Philadelphia and the technology is so outdated that it is not compatible with any other library in the SEPTLA (Southeastern Pennsylvania Theological Library Association) network. Frequent failures in the software place the entire catalog in jeopardy.
